#### Abstract

Named after General "Mad Anthony" Wayne, Wayne County once encompassed the entire lower peninsula of Michigan, and parts of northern Ohio, Indiana and Illinois. As the other states formed and additional counties in Michigan were formed, the county became smaller. According to the 2020 census, Wayne County was populated with nearly 1.8 million residents, making it the 19<sup>th</sup> most populated county in the country.

### **Scope and Content**

The Wayne County Government Documents record group is composed of various records related to the functioning of county functions. Records range from drain assessments for cities throughout the county, school and county tax rolls and birth records. The drain assessment covers the years of 1962 and 1967. The tax assessment rolls range from 1844 until 1977 with information on property numbers, location and description. County birth records are duplicated prints of the late 19<sup>th</sup> and early 20<sup>th</sup> centuries.
