Abstract

John McLaren bought some grain elevators in 1901. In 1906, when his son joined the grain handling firm, the business was incorporated and became J. D. McLaren Co., Inc. Within 14 years, McLaren expanded the business from the original six grain elevators to fifteen, with elevators all over the lower peninsula of Michigan. As the business grew, McLaren expanded from farm related goods to building supplies and fuel. When the elder McLaren died suddenly in 1915, the younger John J. McLaren took over the business.
